**Credit Requirements** - A minimum of 125 credits is required for this degree. An evaluation of transcripts will be necessary to determine the required coursework for transfer students. 50% of the major must be completed at GMercyU, and a minimum total of 45 credits at GMercyU. With appropriate transfer credit and remaining course requirement sequencing, a student may complete the degree in 4 semesters. In certain transfer situations it may take additional time.
